<u>St Bridget of Sweden Feast Day is July 23rd</u>, a Sunday this year. (c. 1303 - 23rd July 1373). She was a Swedish widow, mystic, saint and the founder of the Brigettines. Outside Sweden, she was also known as the Princess of Nericia and was the mother of Catherine of Vadstena. World Day for Grandparents and the Elderly, Sunday, July 23, 2023. Pope Francis inaugurated this World Day to be celebrated by the universal Church each July, either on or near the liturgical Memorial of Saints Joachim and Anne, grandparents of Jesus, to help "treasure the spiritual and human wealth that has been handed down from generation to generation". This year's theme is "His mercy is from age to age" (Lk 1:50), raising the relational interconnection between the old and the young.

<u>Plenary Indulgence for World Grandparents Day</u> The indulgence will be granted to grandparents, the elderly, and all faithful who participate in the solemn celebration presided over by the Pope in St. Peter's Basilica, as well as to all those who attend Mass in various parts of the world. The indulgence is subject to the usual conditions of sacramental Confession as soon as possibly before or following the Mass, reception of the Eucharist, and prayer for the intentions of the Holy Father. A plenary indulgence offers remission of the temporal punishment due to sins already forgiven, which can be applied to one-self or to the souls in Purgatory

Feast of St Anne, Wednesday, July 26. There will be a 2pm Mass at both Indigenous churches to celebrate the grandmother of Jesus. At St Kateri it's preceded by a Novena at 6pm each evening, beginning Sunday, July 16. At Sacred Heart, Rosary in their cemetery will follow Mass. All are welcome. (The regular 7pm Mass at ICC will also be celebrated)
