Family Faith Formation:

Nativity Drama (during 7:00 pm Christmas Eve Mass):

Rehearsal this Sunday after 9:00 am Mass. Parents are encouraged to participate and support the "cast." Your help is so appreciated! See you then.

Children's Liturgy (pre-school/elementary):

During the 9:00 am Sunday Mass. Children proceed to Kinsella I & II where they participate in an ageappropriate reading of the scriptures, reflective discussion on the scriptures, prayers of the faithful, song and an activity if time permits. All children are welcome!

FFF Gatherings (Levels 1/2, Levels 3/4, Levels 5/6):

Usually gather bi-weekly from 10:15 - 11:30 am (but not always depending on the Church season). Schedules are hanging on the white, double doors down the stairs to the right of Veritas. Home Lessons are also available. Program is designed for the family. If a parent is unable to attend, please send your child(ren) with an adult with whom your child is comfortable. Grab a snack in the Hall and head downstairs by 10:15.
