Introduction to this Sunday's Liturgy

In today's Gospel, Jesus passes by the Sea of Galilee and calls the first four disciples, two pairs of brothers: Simon and Andrew, James and John. Follow me, he tells these four fishermen, and I will make you fishers of more disciples. Jesus continues to call disciples; indeed, we were all called when we were baptized. On this Sunday of the Word of God, may the stories of Jonah, of Paul, and of the first four disciples inspire us to drop our nets and follow more closely our Lord as his disciples.

The Feast for the Conversion of St Paul, Apostle



On **January 25**, the faithful celebrate the Conversion of Saint Paul, one of the great events of the early Church. Saul, a student of the great Pharisee rabbi Gamaliel, had persecuted Christians, but was suddenly converted on the road to Damascus when our Lord appeared to him in His resurrected glory (Acts 9:1-9).

Family Faith Formation:

<u>Mass Booklets</u>: Mass Booklets are available every Sunday at the entrances of the Church. Each booklet contains a Mass Moment, Saint Spotlight and other fun activities related to the current season of the Church. This booklet is designed to help children grow deeper in their understanding of the Mass (extras are usually hanging on the white, double-doors down the stairs to the right of Veritas by Monday of each week). <u>Children's Liturgy (pre-school/elementary)</u>: During 9 am Sunday Mass. Children process to Kinsella I&II where they participate in an age-appropriate reading of the scriptures, reflective discussion on the scriptures, prayers of the faithful, song and an activity if time permits. All children are welcome!

Formation Program (Levels 1/2, Levels 3/4, Levels 5/6): Home Lesson this week.

Usually gather bi-weekly from 10:15 - 11:30 am (but not always depending on the Church season). Schedules are hanging on the white, double doors down the stairs to the right of Veritas. Home Lessons are also available. A parent is strongly encouraged to attend with their child as the Program is designed for the family. If a parent is unable to attend, please send your child(ren) with an adult with whom your child is comfortable.
