Confessions will begin from 2:00 pm and continue throughout.






Mass of Celebration - The Feast of St Kateri Tekakwitha

Cemetery Committee

Immaculate Conception Parish is inviting applications from interested parishioners to form a volunteer Parish Cemetery Committee. The parish is responsible for the maintenance of six individual cemeteries in Colchester County. Some of these are currently being maintained by local church committees or by the Truro Cemetery Corporation. Others have very limited or no assets and no one to ensure a quality level of care. Ultimately the properties are owned by the Diocese and the local churches must see to their proper maintenance. The Cemetery Committee of minimum three persons will be charged with drafting standard operating procedures and ensuring the maintenance of all properties in our charge. This will include contracting services if required. There will be no direct financial handling but the Committee will ensure Diocesan approved accounting practices are being followed by all involved.
