(Nov 1) Vigil Candle Light Celebration of All Souls with Mass takes place in three churches:

Sacred Heart at 6:00 pm, Immaculate Conception at 7:00 pm and St Kateri at 6:00 pm All Souls is a liturgical tradition for remembering all those deceased in our personal families and in our family of faith with the celebration of Mass. Here we invite a representative, or a whole family, to come forward and to light a candle in remembrance for the deceased in the past year. Afterwards, all other families may come forward to light a candle for a deceased loved one. It is an expression of your love for them and all of our participation in the Communion of Saints.
