



(May 17&18) New Members Social Welcome to our recently registered families, anyone new and those considering us as their parish. You're invited to visit with Fr Jim and Carol Matthews following our May17&18 Weekend Masses. We want to welcome you while you get to know other parishioners. (May 19) The Parish Office is closed. On Monday May 19th the office will be closed to observe Victoria Day.

(May 22) A Halifax March for Life is organized by Campaign Life Coalition Nova Scotia (CLC NS) on May 22. At 1 PM, Marchers will walk from the meeting point of St. Mary's Cathedral on Spring Garden Rd. to outside Province House where we will peacefully witness to the dignity and humanity of preborn children and pray for an end to abortion For those 29 and under, they are also hosting a Pro-Life Youth Summit that morning from 10:00-12:00, with lunch provided afterwards, and culminating in the March for Life. The event will be focused on the role of social media in the pro-life movement, and how to approach men and women who have a history with abortion. Their guest speakers are Shania Fernandes, a former CLC intern and UN delegate who has experience in using social media to advance the pro-life message, and Madison Gorham, a university student and volunteer with Project Rachel, a post-abortion healing ministry. If any youth wish to attend this event, we ask that they RSVP to ruth@campaignlifecoalition.com. Tickets are \$35 for a single person. Our parish will fund this cost for those wishing to attend.

(May 24) Traditional Latin Mass will be celebrated at St Agnus Church, 6903 Mumford Rd. Halifax. The Mass is at 1030am am on Saturday, May 24 with Fr John Kodet, FSSP. All are invited to experience this form of Mass used until Vatican II in the 1960's. It's also referred to as the Extraordinary Form of the Roman Rite, or as the Tridentine Mass, being codified by the Council of Trent in 1570. This older Roman Rite was superseded by our current Rite, Ordinary Form (Novus Ordo) which uses modern languages. Note, that being a Saturday morning celebration, it is not considered as a replacement for our regular Sunday Mass obligation.

In its second year, a Filipino Catholic tradition will be celebrated at Immaculate Conception Church on **Sunday May 25, 2025** with a 3:00 pm rosary, 4:00pm mass and **Santacruzan** street procession followed by a "Salo-Salo", an evening potluck meal of traditional Filipino food. **All are welcome!**
