

## Introduction to this Sunday's Liturgy

In the days and weeks that followed the Resurrection, the risen Lord kept appearing to his disciples when and where they least expected: in a locked room in Jerusalem, on the road to Emmaus, on the shore of the Sea of Tiberias. Each time, it took a while for them to recognize him. We often fail to recognize him as well, even though we know he continues to appear in our midst today. Whether in the person in need, in God's word, in the Eucharist, or in each other, let us be reminded that he continues to offer his presence to us every day.

(May 25) SANTACRUZAN and FLORES de MAYO. In its second year, a Filipino Catholic tradition will be celebrated at Immaculate Conception Church on **Sunday May 25, 2025** with a 3:00 pm rosary, 4:00 pm mass and Santacruzan street procession followed by a "Salo-Salo", an evening potluck meal of traditional Filipino food.

Introduced by the Spaniards in the Philippines, May is the month dedicated to the Blessed Virgin Mother in her title "Queen of Flowers." The Mayflower festival known as "Flores de Mayo", (Flowers of May), a devotion of floral offerings, Marian songs in honor of the Blessed Virgin Mary culminates in the **SANTACRUZAN**, a colorful vibrant procession, where young women called ""Reynas" Queens in gowns representing images of the Blessed Virgin Mother and biblical figures escorted by young boys ("Constantinos") clad in Filipino attire, "Barong Tagalog" parade on street to reenact the story of how Queen Empress Helena or "Reyna Elena", mother of young Emperor King Constantine the Great uncovered the Holy Cross in which Jesus Christ was crucified. It is an effective way for the younger generation of the Catholic faithful to be catechized in this traditional Filipino pageant. All are welcome!
