



Introduction to this Sunday's Liturgy

Today's readings stress stamina for Moses, persistence for Timothy and Jesus teaching in persistent prayer. It's notably presented in the psalm, "Our help is from the Lord." 




Pope Leo's Prayer Intention for ***October***
